WHY SHOULD YOU CARE ABOUT TRAFFICKING?



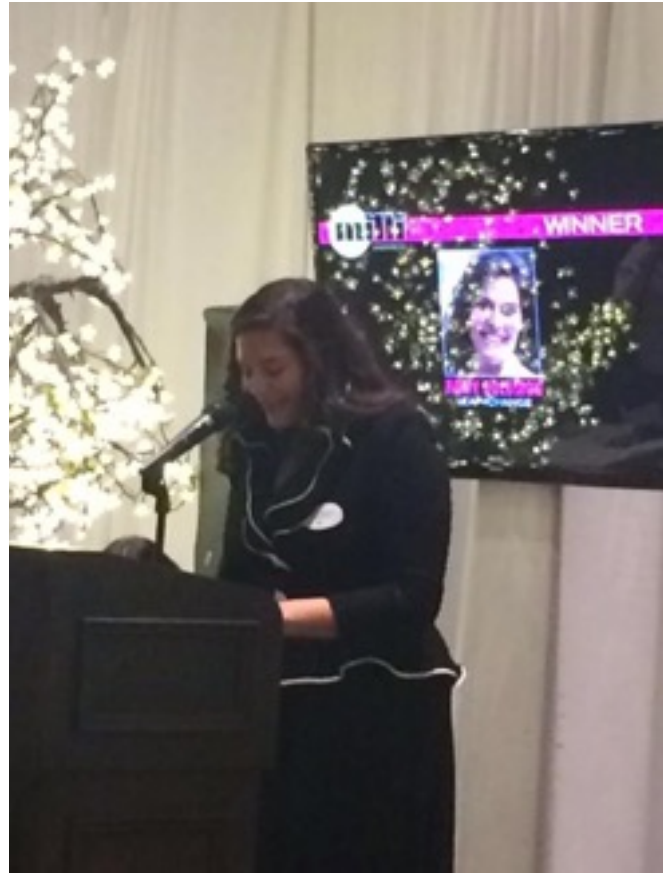

In the United States we are taught in schools that slavery was abolished, but, in fact, there are more slaves in the world today than at the peak of the Trans-Atlantic slave trade. Human trafficking is happening all around you. It's happening in schools, hotels, motels, truck stops, airports, homes, nail salons, restaurants, conference centers, everywhere! One person can't do everything, but we can ALL do something together!

WHO IS YOUR COACH?

Romy Solomon is a leadership coach and program development specialist at LEAP4change. Romy brings her 5 years of international experience managing youth leadership development, experiential education, and human trafficking prevention programs.

Romy served in the Peace Corps in the Republic of Moldova, where she worked as a Community and Organizational Development Advisor. She was the director of Moldova ATIP (Anti-Trafficking in Persons) in charge of facilitating trainings on human trafficking and implementing national events to raise awareness.

Romy was later awarded a Fulbright research grant in Romania, where she worked with NGOs to research innovative new methods of human trafficking prevention for youth. In partnership with the organization, *eLiberare*, Romy established *The Freedom Fighters Academy*, a youth leadership and advocacy training program to equip participants with the professional skills and knowledge to implement anti-trafficking projects of their own design. In November of 2016 Romy was honored with a “Milli Award”, recognized by West fair Communications as a Millennial changing the world.
